SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPANTS:

- When working on a trail that is alongside a street or road, face oncoming traffic as you work and keep an eye on traffic.
- Discontinue work before dusk.
- Do not touch or attempt to remove materials which you suspect may be toxic or hazardous. Items to avoid include powders, chemicals, smelly substances, suspicious packages, chemical drums or containers, weapons, syringes or hypodermic needles, and dead animals. Notify the City, Committee, or the police if any of the above-stated materials are found.
- Do not compact trash bags. Injuries from broken or jagged objects may occur. Be sure to always dispose of trash bags properly. Remember to recycle.
- Always wear bright, colorful clothing while working on trails, especially those that are along a road or street.
- Wear long pants and substantial shoes or boots with ankle support. Watch your footing and stay off steep slopes, drainage facilities or places from which you might fall.
- Do not run, throw objects or engage in horseplay or any other activity that may distract drivers or injure trail users.
- If trail is open to the public during maintenance, stop work, step to upside of trails, and allow users to pass.
- Avoid overexertion. Drink plenty of water, especially on warm, humid days.
- Do not consume alcoholic beverages or drugs before entering or while on the trail.
- Be alert for places where snakes may be located. Also be alert for stinging insects, poison oak, etc.
- Always be aware of your surroundings when swinging any tool.
- Always remember to take out what you bring in.
- A first aid kit must accompany all work crews.

2. Applicant shall indemnify, defend and hold City, its officers, employees, agents and volunteers harmless from and against any and all liability, claims, suits, actions, damages and causes of action arising out of any personal injury, bodily injury, loss of life, or damage to property, or any violation of any federal, state or municipal law or ordinance, or other cause in connection with the negligent or intentional acts or omissions of Applicant, its officers, employees, agents, volunteers or sub-consultants, or on account of the performance or character of this work, except for any such claim arising solely out of the active negligence, sole negligence, or willful misconduct of the City, its officers, employees, agents or volunteers, in performing the work set forth in this project.
3. It is the responsibility of the applicant/volunteer to assure that the Registration Permit Application and volunteer waivers for each participant shall be kept at the site of the work and must be shown to any representative of the City or Trails and Open Space Committee on demand. Work shall be suspended if a complete copy of this Registration Form and volunteer waivers are not available at the site. Any volunteer(s) without a waiver must not participate in the activity.
4. All work shall be conducted in conformance with the "Safety Requirements for Participants" section of this Registration Form (reference page 1).
5. All work shall be conducted during daylight hours.
6. If weather or other adverse circumstances cause a public hazard, work shall be immediately discontinued.
7. Workers shall not cross any traffic lanes of freeways or expressways.
8. Traffic control is prohibited.
9. This permit may be cancelled by the City for non-conformance with permit provisions or failure to adhere to direction given by the City Representative.
10. City must be notified in the event designated representative is replaced.

**ADOPT-A-TRAIL
AGREEMENT AND RELEASE REGARDING
VOLUNTARY SERVICES**

To Whom it May Concern:

This letter is to provide certification that work performed on the Adopt-A-Trail program by volunteers will be provided on a voluntary basis. As such, no compensation and/or reimbursement of any kind will be paid by the City of Yucaipa for these volunteer services. The performance of services hereunder provided by Applicant, its officers, employees, agents and volunteers, shall be in an independent capacity and not as an officer, employee, or agent of the City of Yucaipa. I further understand that accidents and injuries can arise out of the program; knowing the risks, nevertheless, I hereby agree to assume those risks and to indemnify and to hold harmless the City of Yucaipa, its officers, employees, agents and volunteers who, through negligence or carelessness, might otherwise be liable to me, or my heirs or assigns, for damages. It is further understood and agreed that this waiver, release and assumption of risk is to be binding on my heirs and assigns.

I have been advised that the City of Yucaipa's policy is to cover volunteers as employees of the City for the purposes of Workers' Compensation Benefits. I also understand that under Workers' Compensation Laws, Workers' Compensation Benefits will be the sole and exclusive remedy in the event I am injured while performing these volunteer activities and services.

Notwithstanding the Workers' Compensation Benefits as described above, I hereby agree that I, my heirs, guardians, legal representatives and assigns will not make a claim against or file an action against the City of Yucaipa, its officers, employees, or agents for injury or damage resulting from negligence, howsoever caused by any officer, employee, or agent of the City of Yucaipa as a result of my participation in this volunteer activity or service.
