



NOTICE OF COMMISSION AND COMMITTEE VACANCIES

The City of Yucaipa is accepting applications from Yucaipa residents who are interested in serving on a City commission or committee. Yucaipa's commissions and committees offer advice and guidance on important policy decisions for the City which affects daily life. The following commissions and committees will have vacancies effective January 1, 2017 due to expiring terms.

Pursuant to Resolution No. 2014-81, terms shall run consistent with the general municipal election and shall be for two years from January 1st to January 1st. Non-voting student positions serve a single ten-month term, from September to June. Selection and appointments by the City Council are scheduled to be made at the December 12, 2016 City Council meeting.

Additionally, the Economic Development Advisory Committee has (2) At-Large vacancies. There is one vacancy for the Public Representative position and one vacancy for the Alternate Local Development Representative position. These positions have no term end date.
