California Public Resources Code Section 5164 prohibits the City of Yucaipa ("City") from hiring any person for an employment in any position, or hiring any person as a volunteer to perform any services, at any City-operated park, playground or recreational center or beach used for recreational purposes, in a position having supervisory or disciplinary authority over any minor if the job applicant or volunteer has been convicted of certain crimes. Public Resources Code Section 5164 requires that each prospective employee or volunteer complete an application that asks if the person has been convicted of any specified offense(s). In addition, Public Resources Code Section 5164 provides for a criminal background check, which requires fingerprinting.

Since you have applied for employment or applied to serve as a volunteer with the City of Yucaipa for a position covered by Public Resources Code Section 5164, please answer the following supplemental questionnaire. **Completion of the supplemental questionnaire and successful completion of a criminal history background investigation (including fingerprinting) is required as a condition of consideration of your application for employment or to serve as a volunteer with the City of Yucaipa.**

PLEASE NOTE: A conviction is not an automatic bar to employment with the City of Yucaipa. Each case will be considered on its own merits. The City is NOT seeking information about convictions for possession of marijuana and certain other marijuana-related offenses that are more than two years old if the convictions resulted under California Health & Safety Code Sections 11357(b), 11357(c) (or statutory predecessor), or Health & Safety Code Sections 11360(c), 11364 or 11550. You may exclude information about: (i) any convictions that have been legally expunged, sealed, or statutorily eradicated, (ii) a referral to and participation in any pretrial or posttrial diversion program, and (iii) any arrests that did not result in conviction. You must disclose information about any arrest(s) for which you are out on bail or on your own recognizance pending trial.

- A felony or misdemeanor conviction that is over 10 years old, if the subject of the request was incarcerated within 10 years of the City's request, for a violation or attempted violation of an offense specified in Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 207) of Title 8 of Part 1 of the Penal Code; Section 211 or 215 of the Penal Code, wherein it is charged and proved that the defendant personally used a deadly or dangerous weapon, as provided in Penal Code Section 12022 (b) in the commission of that offense; Penal Code Section 217.1; Penal Code Section 236; an offense specified in Chapter 9 (commencing with Section 240) of Title 8 of Part 1 of the Penal Code; or an offense specified in Penal Code Section 667.5 (c).
