DELAYED DUE TO WEATHER INTERSTATE 10 PAVEMENT PROJECT IN YUCAIPA TO BEGIN MID-FEBRUARY 2019

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) must delay the start of the pavement rehabilitation project on Interstate 10 (I-10) in the City of Yucaipa, west of Live Oak Canyon Road to County Line Road undercrossing. **Work was expected to begin February 4, but has been delayed to mid-February 2019, weather permitting.**

Work will occur at night from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. on the #3 lane, shoulders and ramps in both directions. This \$33 million project, awarded to Coffman Specialties, Inc., will extend the life of the pavement and is expected to be completed in October 2020.
