**Step 3: Reservation Policy**

User hereby agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless City of Yucaipa, its officers, officials, employees and volunteers from and against any and all claims, damages, losses and expenses that may arise during or be caused in any way by such occupancy or use of facilities, but the user shall not be liable for any claims, damages, losses and expenses caused by the sole negligence or willful misconduct of the City of Yucaipa. User shall have received any and all permission or license(s) as may be required to perform or use any protected materials in its use of the facility. User agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the City, its elected officials, employees and agents from and against any and all claims, penalties, and/or damages which may accrue as a result of user's failure to comply with this requirement.

- Cancellation of a rental or changing a confirmed date will result in loss of deposit. If the facility can be rebooked with a comparable rental then 75% of the applicant's deposit will be returned. Cancellation fourteen (14) days or less prior to an event will result in the loss of any rental fees paid in addition to the deposit.
- Decorations require prior approval by facility reservation personnel. No signs or decorations will be nailed or permanently affixed to the facility walls, ceilings, windows or drapes. Decorations must be fireproof. No glitter, rice, birdseed or other similar items will be allowed to be thrown in or around the facility.
- No smoke or bubble machines are allowed. If smoke alarms are activated due to the use of such items, which result in the call out of the City of Yucaipa Fire Department, applicant will be responsible for all charges incurred by the Fire Department and the City of Yucaipa. DJ's or bands are permitted at the event upon facility reservation personnel approval.
- The rental ending time means the facility must be empty of all guests. The rental ending time may not occur later than 10:00 p.m. Applicant is responsible for all clean-up of the facility.
- City staff will not sign for any items that have been rented. If items are delivered before the rental time or picked up after the rental times, the applicant will be charged the regular hourly rate.
- Applicant must be present at event for the duration of the event. The facility will not be opened unless Applicant is present.
- Smoking is prohibited in all City parks and facilities (reference City Park Ordinance No. 256).

## Pool Rules

Pool rules are designed for the safety of everyone. The City of Yucaipa reserves the right to amend these rules for the safety of its participants. The City of Yucaipa also reserves the right to refuse service to any participant who violates any rule or ignores direction from aquatic staff.

- All persons entering the facility are required to pay the admission fee.
- Proper swim wear must be worn at all times. See “Proper Swim Attire” for more information.
- No person shall enter the pool complex without a lifeguard present.
- Diapered patrons must wear approved swim diapers. Swim diaper must be worn under proper swim attire.
- A complete head and body shower must be taken before entering the pool.
- Hanging on ropes or lane lines is not permitted.
- Hanging, swinging and sitting on hand rails is not permitted.
- No smoking, alcohol, or illegal substances. Individuals assumed to be under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs will not be permitted to enter the facility.
- No gum chewing, glass containers, or weapons.
- No running, pushing, shoving or horseplay in the pool or on the deck.
- No chicken fights, intentional splashing or foul language.
- No animals—with the exception of medical assistance dogs. Cell phones, cameras and video cameras may not be used in the locker rooms.
- The City of Yucaipa is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged articles.
- Only lifeguards are permitted on lifeguard stands.

### **PROPER SWIM ATTIRE**

Proper swim attire must be worn by ALL patrons choosing to swim in the pool, including the Splashpad. If you have any questions regarding what is or is not proper swim attire, please look below or contact (909) 790-7460.

#### **Swimwear Allowed:**

- Board Shorts: must be shorts with a tie or drawstring that are made out of a material that is designated for use in the water.
- One & Two Piece Swim Suits: made out of a material that is designed for use in the water. String or thong bathing suits are not permitted.
- Rash Guards: fitted swim shirts designed for use in water and made of material suitable for use in water.
- Speedos & Jammers: and other tight fitting swimwear designed for swimming and competition use.

#### **Not Allowed:**

- Athletic shorts: including any kind of basketball, soccer, volleyball, yoga, running or jogging shorts.
- Athletic shirts: including jerseys, under armor, and other tight fitting athletic shirts.
- Denim Clothing: including shorts, jeans, pedal shorts, capris, cut offs, and jackets.
- Dresses & Cover Ups: including sun dresses, summer dresses, sarongs, skirts, cover-ups, and other clothing not manufactured as a “Swim Dress”.
- Cotton Shirts: including T-Shirts, graphic tees, polo shirts, button ups, tie-dye shirts, tank tops, camisoles and undershirts.
- Under Garments: Sport bras, boxers, briefs and bras may not be worn in the pool.
- Revealing or Inappropriate Clothing: any clothing that depicts violent or inappropriate behavior, provocative swimsuits, or any clothing perceived as gang related.
