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### **Pavement Management Program Update**

The City of Yucaipa is pleased to announce the recent completion of this year's Street Paving Program. As part of the City's Pavement Management Program, the paving work plays a critical role in extending the service life of our streets. The program helps to enhance our local roadways and ensures the pavement conditions are safe for all users. According to Mayor Bogh, "this year's program effort has been the largest investment in paving the City has ever completed." In August of 2021, the Yucaipa City Council awarded a \$2.8 million contract to Matich Corporation. The work consisted of asphalt resurfacing and overlay, pavement patch work, and restriping. The City was successfully able to pave approximately eighteen lane miles of roadway in our community.



In the process of evaluating pavement conditions, the City utilizes state of the art technology provided by Infrastructure Management Services (IMS). IMS is an industry leader that utilizes laser-cameras to collect pavement data which provides information regarding the strength and condition of the pavement. The data collected is used to create an index which rates the pavement, provides a cost analysis as well as a rehabilitation strategy for City staff to review. Every 5 years, IMS

surveys the pavement conditions throughout our community to ensure accurate data is available for the Street Paving Program.
