### **Pavement Repair Work at Sunnyside Dr. and Oak Glen Road**

As part of the Woodside Homes development, the contractor was required to install a modified traffic signal at the intersection of Sunnyside Dr. and Oak Glen Road. As a result of this traffic signal modification and the previous utility work, Woodside's contractor is scheduled to perform pavement repair work at the intersection of Sunnyside Dr. and Oak Glen Road on Saturday, March 5 and Monday, March 7.

On Saturday, March 5 from 5 a.m. to 5 p.m., the contractor will be removing the old pavement and striping at this intersection. As a result of this work, there will be intermittent lane closures taking place on Oak Glen Road as well as intermittent closures to Sunnyside Dr. During the closure of Sunnyside Dr., a detour will be in place for residents and visitors that wish to access the Yucaipa Community Park or the Bryant Glen Sports Complex.

On Monday, March 7, from 5 a.m. to 5p.m., the contractor will permanently restripe the intersection. This work may involve intermittent delays as the contractor stripes the crosswalks and lanes. The City is working with the contractor to help mitigate any delays that could occur during school drop-off and pick-up times.

"I would like to remind visitors and residents to drive with caution as they approach the work zone; this work is critical to enhance the safety of this intersection. I appreciate the



community's understanding and patience as this project is completed," said Mayor David Avila.
