

ORDINANCE NO. 330

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF YUCAIPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 270, ESTABLISHING COUNCIL COMPENSATION.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUCAIPA DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Purpose

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to Section 36516 of the Government Code, which authorizes a City Council to provide by ordinance that each member of the Council may receive a salary based upon the population of the city as determined by census or by a certified estimate made by the State Department of Finance and may be increased by an amount not to exceed 5% per year for each subsequent year since the last increase was operative (2008).

Section 2. Population and Time from Operative Date of Last Adjustment

On the date the Council last adjusted the salary of council members by Ordinance 270, the latest estimate of population of the City of Yucaipa made by the State Department of Finance was 51,784. On the date this ordinance is adopted, the latest population estimate by the State Department of Finance is 52,100. The operative date of this ordinance will be six years following the operative date of Ordinance 270.

Section 3. Salaries

Each member of the City Council shall receive the sum of Six Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$650) per month at a maximum allowable increase of 5% per year since the most recent increase was operative. The salary is payable at the same time and in the same manner as the salary paid to each of the officers and employecs of the City.

Section 4. Increase or Decrease

Increases and decreases in the City Council compensation shall be in conformance with Section 36516 and 36516.5 of the Government Code. The effective date of an adjustment in the salaries of the City Council members is delayed pursuant to Section 36516.5 until one Council member commences a new term of office.

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
Section 5. Reimbursement

The salaries prescribed by this ordinance are exclusive of any other amount payable to a member of the City Council as reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred by him/her in the performance of his/her official duties.

Section 6. Effective Date

This Ordinance will take effect after certification of the November 4, 2014 election results.
